Mark Palla commented about his perception that there was unfair treatment for landowners depending on whether they were currently irrigating or not. Hilary Graves responded that the District was not the determining agency for this and that he should consider contacting the Board of Supervisors to provide his comments. Jerry Reaugh further explained that the ordinance does not parcel out water, only what can be planted. Mr. Palla commented on the exemption increase to 25AF/Y and Hilary Graves explained the District's comments regarding keeping the exemption to 5AF/Y due to the potential for a very large increase in the stresses on the Basin should the 4,900 currently non-irrigated parcels decide to take their 25 AF/Y exemption, and referred Mr. Palla to his supervisorial representative for an explanation about why the County would consider the increase.
