ITEM 5: CONSIDER REVISED PROPOSAL FOR CONTINUOUS MONITORING PRGRAM FROM GSI, INC.

Jerry Reaugh reported that the sensors have been ordered. The expected cost will exceed the original proposal amount. Jerry Reaugh will report in March with update on the proposal.

### **ITEM 6: UPDATE ITEMS**

- a. Joint meeting with Shandon-San Juan Water District January 30, 2023 regarding groundwater sustainability, SGMA, GSP compliance, and project advancement

  Jerry Reaugh reported a meeting attendance of approximately 45 people. Supervisor Bruce Gibson attended and is working on reaching out to stakeholders. Hilary Graves pointed out the value of the joint meeting paradigm and suggested holding joint meetings more frequently with a workshop format. ECPWD's potential reaffirmation of becoming a GSA was discussed. Blaine Reely presented updated information on the MILR program in development at the
- b. SLO County Board of Supervisors meetings January 24, 2023, January 29, 2023 and February 7, 2023
  - The supervisors voted to rescind the recently-passed Paso Basin Land Use Management Area ordinance. Dana Merrill reiterated the concern of increasing the exemption from 5 AF to 25 AF that was part of the now-rescinded ordinance. During the supervisors' meeting, Bruce Gibson requested that the EIR be decertified and that staff revisit the Water Neutral New Development ordinance (now back in place as part of the rescission), including looking at off site offsets and fallowing. He also touched on the MILR program and that the best way to manage the Basin was through SGMA as opposed to County Land Use authority.
- c. Paso Basin Cooperative Committee meeting January 25, 2023 (cancelled, next meeting March 16)
- d. Groundwater Levels Monitoring program (Taken out of order at beginning of Update Items)
  Monitoring is scheduled for February, April, August and November. The District is now beginning year three of the program.
- e. State Water Consulting project (no January meeting, next meeting March 3)

  The potential to use unallocated State Water for the Basin's benefit is being included in possible projects in Blaine Reely's office. The District is willing to support that possibility. Jerry Reaugh reported that DWR has upped the delivery from 5% to 25-30% because of the recent storms. Dana Merrill asked about stream gages, and Jerry Reaugh intends to follow up with Nate Page (GSI, Inc.), and Willy Cunha (SSJWD).
- f. WRAC meeting February 1, 2023 (no December meeting)
  No update was provided.

# ITEM 7: REPORT FROM GSA AD HOC COMMITTEE. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING REAFFIRMING EPCWD'S INTEREST IN BECOMING A GSA

Hilary Graves expressed that it is time to bring up becoming a GSA, and thanked Jerry Reaugh for his work on the possible reaffirmation letter to the Board of Supervisors. Dana Merrill pointed out that becoming a GSA was one of the primary reasons the District was formed. A general discussion of

reaffirmation followed, with consensus on supporting reaffirmation. Kathleen March, a District landowner, expressed support for the District becoming a GSA. Jerry Reaugh stressed that this year is when many GSP implementation decisions will start happening and being part of that process is important.

Hilary Graves and Lee Nesbitt volunteered to be an ad hoc committee to develop a potential District equity statement. Kathleen March discussed the Cuyama Basin's GSP and approach to cut backs.
